## Dear Parent/Guardian:

You child is currently registered in a math course at Cambie that requires the use of a TI-83 Graphing Calculator. We have a set number of calculators that we can rent to students for the duration of the year for students who are unable to purchase their own. With increasing demands on school resources and ever decreasing school budgets, we try to maximize student success by asking only those students who absolutely need to borrow calculators to do so. In order to sign out one of the school calculators, you must do the following:

- Bring a deposit cheque to the Math teacher for $\$ 140$ addressed to H.J. Cambie Secondary School post-dated to June $1^{\text {st }}, 2017$ along with your child's full name and student number on the memo line.
- Bring another cheque or cash payment of $\$ 20$ as rental fee.

Once the calculator is returned in good condition at the end of the year, we will return the deposit cheque of $\$ 140$. We will only cash the cheque only if the calculator is no longer functioning or not returned. Additionally, you will need to provide your own set of 4 AAA batteries for the calculator.

We are unfortunately not able to sign out graphing calculators on a daily basis, so please ensure that your child brings his/her calculator to every math class.
